In the 2019 Havering Partnership Awards we won six Awards for the most improved progress or attainment in the borough in key academic areas. We are part of the Success for All Educational Trust with Redden Court and Sanders school and this provides many opportunities for collaboration to enhance provision and outcomes for all students across the Trust.

Our vision is: 'To be a Growth Mindset Community where ambition, hard work and resilience makes success for all a reality' and we work tirelessly to embed this in all aspects of the school's work.
