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## Home School Agreement

- Wear my school uniform in a way that is a credit to myself and the school.
- Be positive about school and participate in the school community in any way I can.
- Keep my planner up to date and be responsible for taking home information my parents need to know.

### **Parents/Carers**

*As parents/carers we will do our best to.....*

- Send our son to school every day, on time and in full uniform.
- Encourage him to complete home learning and to attend extra-curricular activities.
- Keep the school informed of any problems that might affect his learning.
- Ensure he is properly prepared each day to take a full part in school.
- Attend parent evenings, academic monitoring meetings and other meetings provided by the school.
- Treat all the staff who work at the school with respect and courtesy.
- Support the school and its policies on behaviour and home learning as fully as possible.
- Not take him out of school for family holidays.
- Encourage him to be positive about school and always do his best.
- Monitor our son's progress through the school's data systems (Go4schools and Show My Homework).

- Provide students with a safe, well-ordered and caring environment.
- Provide students with high quality learning.
- Provide a broad curriculum that meets the needs of students and encourages them to widen their horizons.
- Encourage students to work to the best of their ability and to attend school regularly.
